House Education Reform Committee advances bill to expand dual enrollment: “Legislation from Rep. Aaron Miller (R-Sturgis) that would allow for student dual enrollment to include out-of-state facilities within 20 miles of a shared border was advanced last week by the House Education Reform Committee.”
